Acton Public Library - Crockfest Registration Form

Deadline for entries is October 30th, 2022 or as soon as all the limited spaces are filled.

You may register in person at the library or by mail. Please make checks payable to Acton Public Library.

Please bring ready-to-serve chili or chowder in a completely filled crockpot Be prepared to serve up to 150 people, that is about 300 ounces or 9.5 quarts of food.

Entries must be homemade and an ingredient list must be displayed for voters. Sharing your recipe is optional.

- Contestants can arrive by 11:00 AM to set up assigned table space and must be ready to serve by 11:30 AM. If you would like your table to be near another contestant please let us know by Oct. 26th. You will be provided a 3' x 2.5' table space you may decorate. Decorations may include advertising for businesses, organizations, and family names. Prize awarded to BEST **DECKED-OUT Table!!**
- Contestants will be responsible for serving chili/chowder in 2 ounce sample cups. Ladles and 100 numbered cups will be provided by the Acton Public Library. You will be provided more cups and a sharple to number yourself after 100.
- Doors will open to the public at 12 PM.
- Guests will pay \$10 per person (\$40 family maximum) for a 2 ounce sample of each entry and a voting ballot to vote for their favorite in both the chili and chowder categories.
- Contestants' entry fee includes one free voting ballot to sample all entries and voting privileges for the category in which you are not competing.
- Winners will be announced between 1:30 & 2:00 PM and will be determined by the contestant with the highest number of votes.
- A \$75 cash prize and bragging rights will be awarded to the 1st place winner in each category.
- 2nd & 3rd place winners will be announced.
- All decisions by the Acton Public Library Director and Board of Trustees are final.
